Objections, if any, must be in writing and must be filed with the Clerk of the United States Bankruptcy Court by the close of business, February 20, 2009. If no objections are timely filed, the Trustee will present an Order, *ex parte*, granting the relief sought and the hearing shall be stricken.

TRUSTEE'S APPLICATION FOR INTERIM COMPENSATION

Michael B. McCarty, the Chapter 7 Trustee, has filed his first application for interim compensation in this case in the amount of \$9,365.80. The application is on file with the Clerk of the U.S. Bankruptcy Court where it may be reviewed. The amount requested is the maximum amount that has not been approved and paid under section 326 of the Bankruptcy Code.

MOTION REGARDING ACCOUNTS RECEIVABLE

The debtor scheduled a substantial amount of accounts receivable that had been assigned to two collection companies for collection. The Court denied the Trustee's Motion to hire the two collection companies. Subsequent to the entry of the Order the Trustee instructed both collection companies to cease active collection activities. However, some payments continued to come in on some of the accounts. The Trustee requests that the Court authorize acceptance of these payments but direct Elliott Bay Adjustment Co. Inc. to refund any payments it receives after the date of the Order to the payor.
